# What is Swing Bed?

Swing bed is skilled care (non-acute care) delivered in a hospital for patients who need short-term rehabilitation after an acute hospitalization.

### **Rehabilitation Services include:**

#### **Skilled Nursing**

Daily sterile dressing changes, long-term IV medication administration, enteral nutrition, complex care and assessments

#### **Physical Therapy**

Complex wound management and interventions to restore function, strength, and mobility

#### **Occupational Therapy**

Interventions to restore independence with activities of daily living, home safety assessments, wheelchair and adaptive equipment needs

#### **Speech Therapy**

Cognitive rehabilitation and interventions to restore swallow, speech, and language

#### **Respiratory Therapy**

Develops treatment plans for post-acute care respiratory needs

#### When would swing bed be beneficial for me?

- After joint replacement surgery
- After an accident with injuries
- After a major surgery or prolonged illness
- IV medications (antibiotics, nutrition)
- For complex care management
